That record is also a tough one to come by. And you'll hear a real gem by **Ralph O'Brien & The Sons of Erin** from the early '70s. The song is Phil Coulter's *Scorn Not His Simplicity* and it did not appear on either of the Sons LPs! Ralph's rendition of this song blew my mind. And we've got a 3 minute drum solo from a single released by Gander's **Seven Years Later** in 1972. Plus there's plenty more vinyl treasures.
